This case study is presented as an interactive “browser” for teachers, containing all the instructions, lesson plans, resources and supplementary materials necessary to run the case study.

Double-click on **Start** for an overview and index page.

Hardware & software requirements

The case study can be browsed using Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox or any web browser which supports “frames”, and should be “cross-platform”.

Either an interactive whiteboard or a data projector is required to present videos and images to students. Pupils require access to spreadsheet software in lesson 4 (the guide refers to Excel but other spreadsheet software could be used). Calculators and stopwatches may also be needed.

The video clips require Windows Media Player or other video media player that can play .wmv files. Users of non-Windows machines may require extra software for this (such as VLC from <http://www.videolan.org/vlc/>).

For PC users, *Adobe Reader* (or similar) is required to view the guides and handouts. *Adobe Reader* is available to download for free from:
