



# GLOSSARY

<b>Arid</b>	Extremely dry; without moisture.
<b>Compound Measure</b>	Combination of two or more measures by applying a mathematical operation such as multiplication or division.
<b>Cubic Metre</b>	A container measuring one metre in length, width and depth.
<b>Mathematical Procedure</b>	<p>Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division are examples of these.</p> <p>Also known as mathematical operation.</p>
<b>Plateau</b>	An area of high flat land; a mountain with a wide, flat top.
<b>Square Kilometre</b>	A square measuring one kilometre on each side.
<b>Terrain</b>	The surface features of an area of land.
<b>Total Area</b>	Amount of land in a country.
<b>Total Population</b>	Everyone living in a country.
<b>Total Water Available</b>	The amount of water in a country in a year. This includes rivers, rain, and other water sources.
<b>Units</b>	Any specified amount of a quantity (as of length, volume, force, momentum, or time) that serves as a standard and facilitates comparisons.
