Turkey

Turkey is located in Southeastern Europe and Southwestern Asia. You can see that much of Turkey is surrounded by saltwater seas. Around it lie the Black Sea, the Aegean Sea, and the Mediterranean Sea. The water from these seas is not drinkable.

Turkey has a wide variety of land, including mountain ranges, flat plains and plateaus.

It has hot dry summers, and mild winters.

Turkey has about 70 million people. About two-thirds of the people live in urban areas, and one-third lives in rural areas.

Much of Turkey's water is used for farming.

Jordan

This country is located in the Middle East, just northwest of Saudi Arabia. Except for some small saltwater seas along the west, Jordan is surrounded by land.

It has some mountains along its western border but the rest of the country is mostly flat plains and plateaus.

It is hot and arid most of the year, but the west of the country has wet winters.

Jordan has about 5 million people. About three-quarters live in urban areas and one-quarter live in rural areas.

Much of Jordan's water is used for farming.

Algeria

Located in Northern Africa, bordering the Mediterranean Sea, Algeria has some mountains, and is mostly flat plains, plateaus, and desert. Part of the Sahara desert is in Algeria.

It is hot and arid in most of the country, except in the north. The north borders the Mediterranean Sea so it has wet winters.

About 31 million people live in Algeria. Slightly more people live in urban areas than rural areas.

Like the other 2 countries, much of Algeria's water is used for farming.
