TV REPORTER:

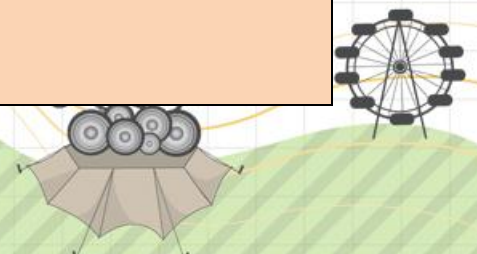
So what's been your highlight so far?
